

Can you find any flowers growing outside this week? Here is an example of one flower you might find: a dandelion. Last week, you may have found a dandelion in your tea or outside in your neighborhood. The image on the left is the flower. After a dandelion flower blooms, the petals die and seeds form so it can reproduce. The wind catches these seeds and carries them to their new home where they will root and become a new plant. Do you see any dandelions? What kind(s) of flowers do you see? If you find a dandelion like the one on the right, pick it and blow on it and watch the seeds go to their new homes!
