# *Introduction*

- Seeds came from flowers that have been pollinated.
- A seed is a plant embryo (baby) that functions as a way for plant to multiply themselves.





## *Seed planting in nature....*

Some seeds fall straight to the ground and grow into plants, and some Seeds Travel.

There are 3 main ways that seeds travel: through water, animals, or the air (flying or bursting).



# *Seed Germination*

When a seed begins to grow it is called a sprout, and the seed is germinated. If they have the right conditions, the seed will grow into a new plant!
