THE WILLAMETTE VALLEY GROWING ZONE

THIS IS THE WILLAMETTE VALLEY

This is where most Oregonians live and where a lot of Oregon's food is grown.



THE UNITED STATES HAS GROWING ZONES

All of these zones have different temperatures and tell us when it is ok to plant certain plants. This helps us because some plants don't like the cold and can only go in the ground when it starts to get warmer.



IN THE WILLAMETTE VALLEY, WE LIVE IN ZONE 8

This means that it can get some freezing in the winter, but doesn't last too long, and things start to warm up in the early to mid spring.



SO IF YOU WANT TO START PLANTING, START IN MARCH OR APRIL!

March is usually when things start getting warm and comfy for our plant friends!
